
# **PROTECT YOUR VOTE!**

## Fill out your Absentee Ballot envelope carefully.

Absentee (Mail-In) ballots can be rejected if the Return Envelope is not filled out properly.



### Return your ballot promptly.

#### **Return by DROP BOX.**

To avoid delays through the postal service, drop off your ballot at your county or city's drop box.

Where? Locations you may use are listed on the instruction page that came with your ballot.

**When?** We recommend you turn in your ballot as soon as possible. Ballots must be dropped off at your county or city's drop box before the close of polls, 7 pm on Election Day, Tues. Nov 5.

#### Return by MAIL.

If you decide to mail in your ballot, do it as soon as possible.

To be counted, a Mail-In ballot must be <u>postmarked</u> on or before Election Day, Tues, Nov 5. It must <u>arrive</u> by noon Fri, Nov. 8.

### \*You can still vote in person, if you decide not to bother with the absentee ballot.

Just turn in your unused absentee ballot at an Early Voting location or your polling place on Election Day — then Vote In-Person with a regular ballot.
