



2025 Cabinet Nominee for FBI Director

Kash Patel

Since J. Edgar Hoover's long, often disturbing, reign, FBI Directors have been nominated to 10-year terms to enforce the law without fear or favor, Independent of the White House. They swear allegiance to the Constitution, not the President.

Many a Democratic President has retained a Republican President's appointed FBI Director because they trust that they will put Country over partisanship.

Kash Patel, however, is not your usual nominee to lead the Bureau.
